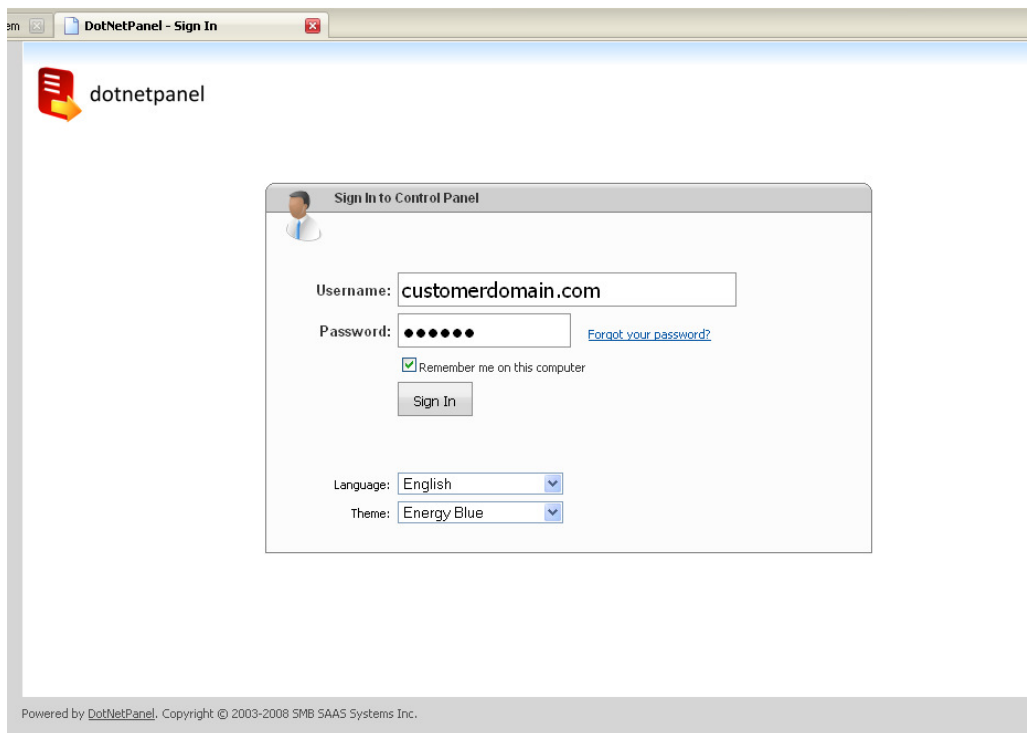


## Creating Email Forwarders- DotNetPanel

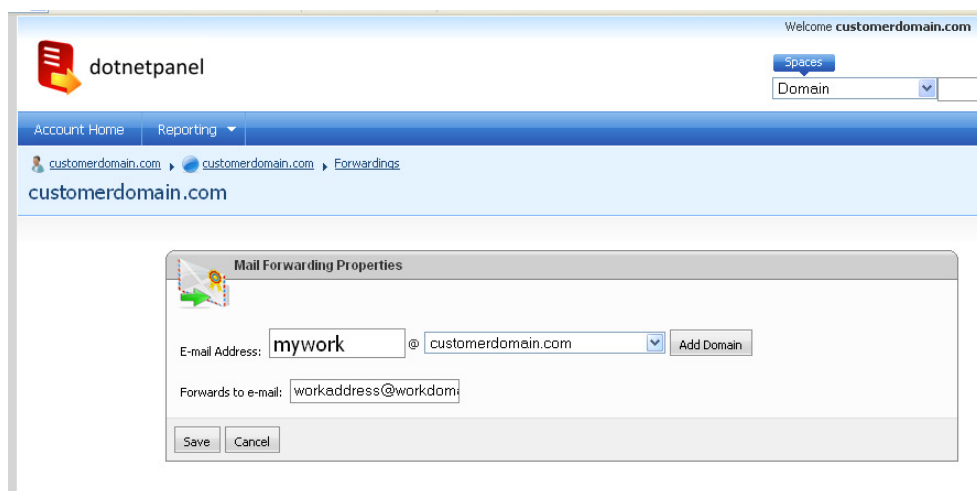
This guide will take you through the steps of creating a new email forwarder (or alias) on the DotNetPanel. This email forwarder will allow you to essentially forward any email sent to one email address to a different email account- without the sender realising it.

1. The first step is to log into the DotNetPanel. Visit <https://cp.eurofasthost.com/> using your web browser- whether that is Internet Explorer or Firefox.
2. Type in your login information you were provided by your welcome email. Your username will generally be your domain. If you forgot your password you can use our *“Forgot your password”* link on the front page.



3. After logging in you will be sent to our Account Home page. There will be a link with your domain on it- click it.
4. You will now be sent to your Hosting Space. This will provide you with the interface to modify your account. To create an email forwarder, use the left menu and put your mouse over **Mail**, then select **Forwardings**.

5. Click the button that says "Create Mail Forwarding". In the first box type the name of the email address you want to use as the forwarder- in this example I used *mywork* (creating a forwarder of *mywork@customerdomain.com*). Select the domain from the drop down menu, and then type in the email address where you want the email to be forwarded to. Once you are happy, click **Save**.



6. Please note that due to spam issues, we are no longer able to forward to external email accounts- such as Hotmail, AOL and Yahoo.
